



How to create: Paper Christmas Tree

Tree size: 18cm (W) x 15cm (H) x 18cm (D)

For cricut machine (estimated time : 45 mins)

For hand cut (estimated time : 1 hour 30 mins)

-
- Materials you will need:**
1. Paper size: A4; 160 - 300 gsm (6 sheets) in colours of your choice
 2. Scissors
 3. Pen Knife / Utility Knife
 4. Ruler
 5. Glue (preferably with a pointed tip)
 6. Printer
 7. Bamboo skewers
 8. Nylon string and beads
-

Steps:

1. **Print** template to scale

Part A: Creating the Tree layers

2. **Cut** out the templates by following the bolded lines
3. Using the back side of a pen knife blade, **score** along the dotted lines to create the tree folds
4. **Fold** along the scored dotted lines (refer to Annex A: Dash lines folded out, dotted lines folded in)
5. **Match** the numbers on each tree layer, overlap the flap and **glue** it together
6. **Create** a hole on the top of each tree layer with the bamboo skewer, **stack** the tree layer on top of one another (in this order: 5 → 4 → 3 → 2 → 1)

(at the bottom)(at the top)

Part B: Creating the Tree base

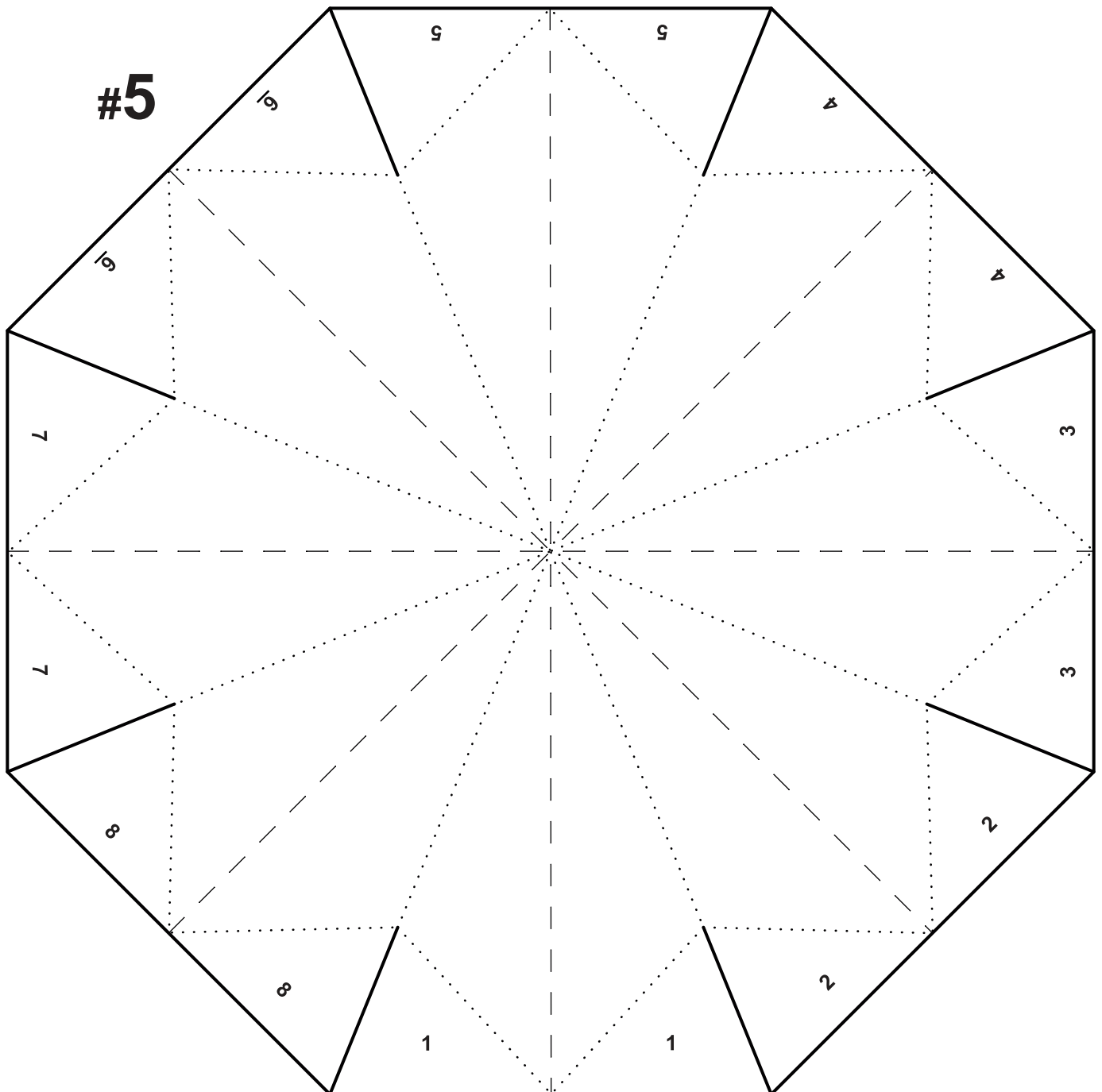
7. **Cut** out item 6, 7 and 8 to construct the base of the tree (refer to Annex B)

Part C: Decorating the Tree (Refer to Annex C)

8. **Decorate** the Tree with some shiny beads by threading a nylon string through it and glue it on the edge
9. Create some presents by matching the numbers on each gift box template. Once the gift box is created, stick it to the base of the log
10. Fold a star (refer to Annex D) and add it to the top of the tree!

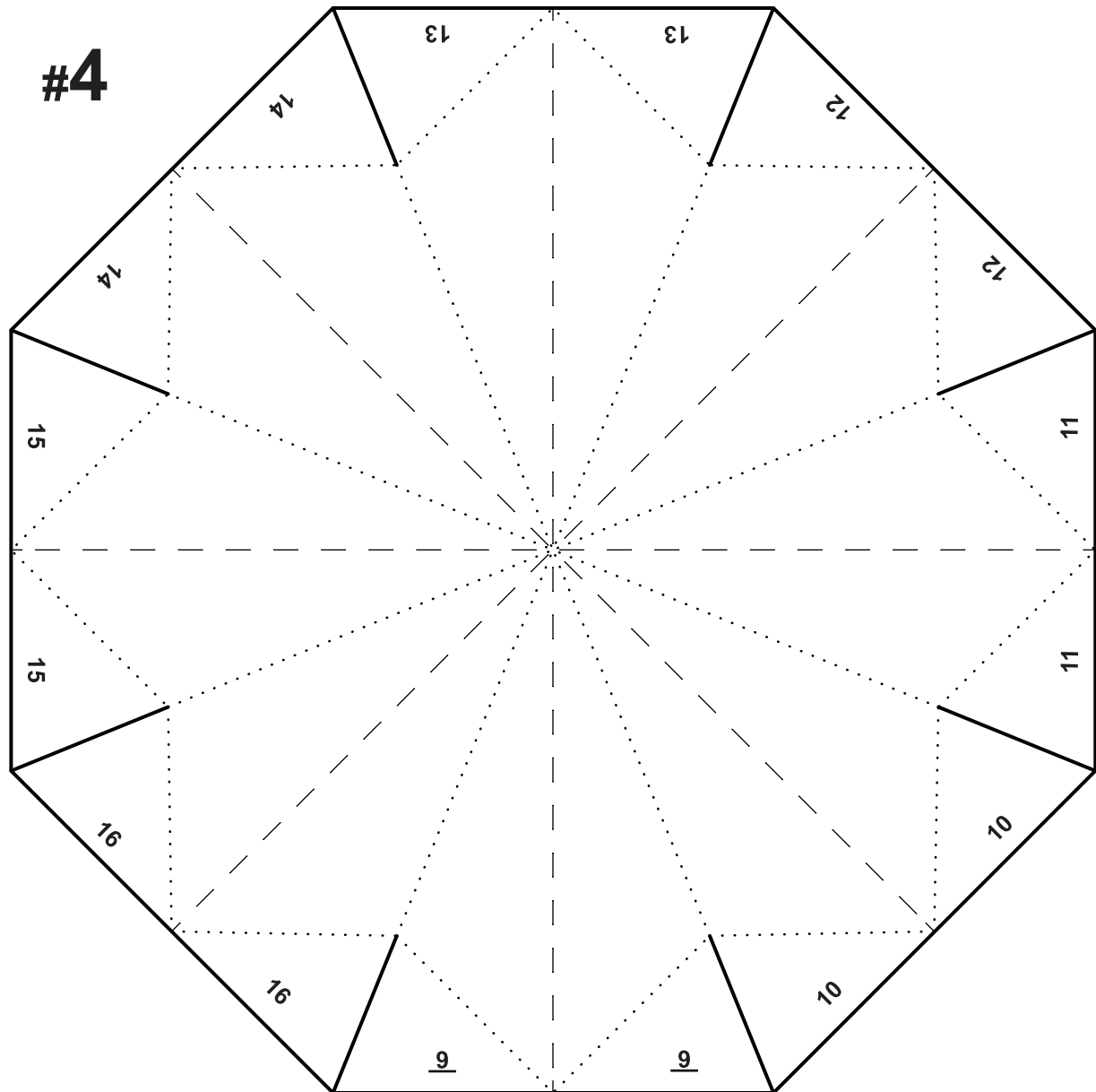

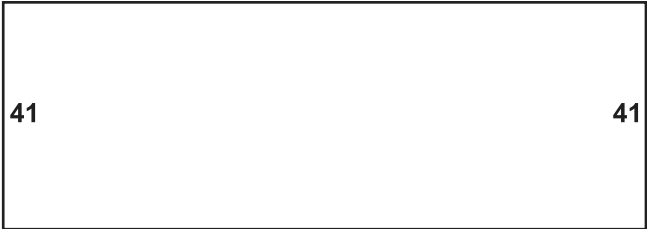


Part B: Base of Tree

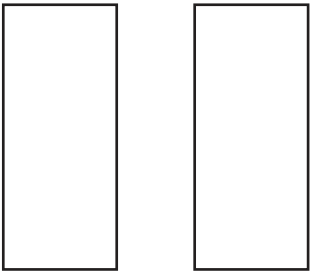

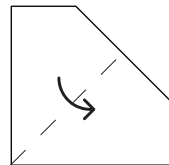
Annex A: Instructions for the tree



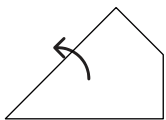
Fold the paper into half



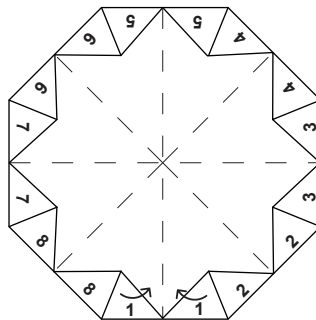
Fold the paper into half



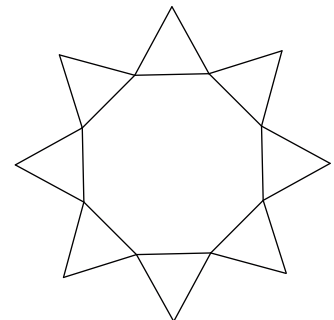
Fold the paper into half



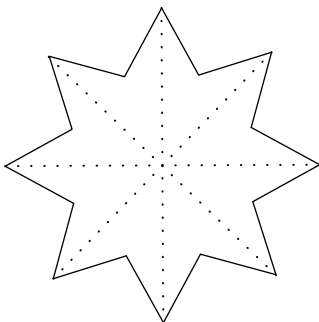
Open up the paper



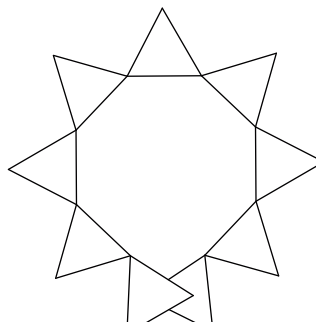
Fold up the corner of every side



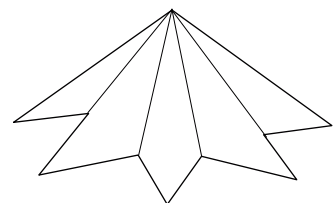
Flip the paper over

and glue it down together

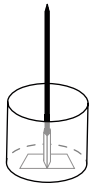


Repeat the steps for
#1, #2, #3, #4

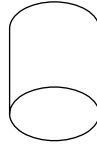
Annex B: Instructions for the tree base



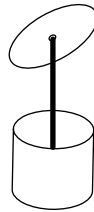
Roll up and glue the numbers together



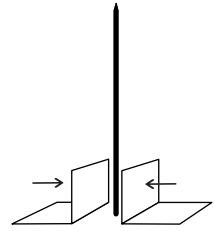
Glue the stand to the base of the tree



Glue down one circle to create the base of the tree

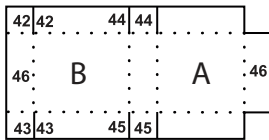


Poke a hole through the other circle and glue it down to the base

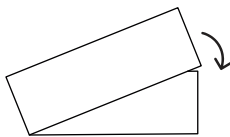


Glue down the two paper flaps to the bottom of the bamboo skewer to create a stand

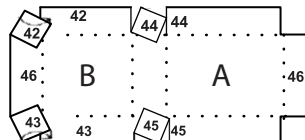
Annex C: Instructions for the present



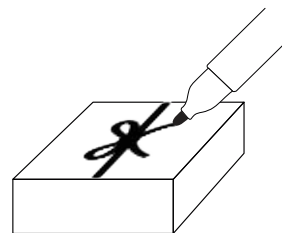
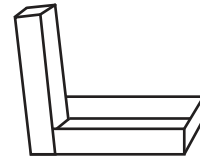
Score along the dotted lines

Match the numbers and glue down to create the present (A-->B)



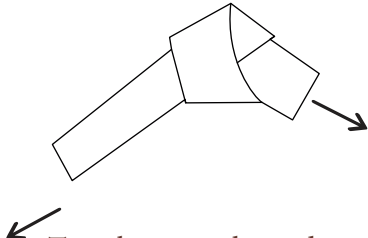
Match the numbers and glue down to assemble base of present (B)



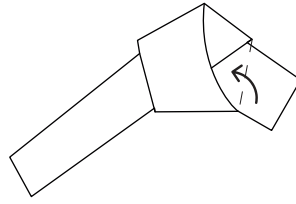
Use a marker or pen to draw a ribbon on the box



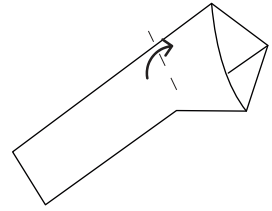
Annex D: Instructions for the star



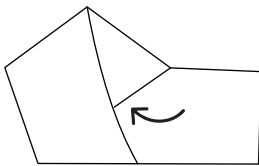
Tie a knot on the end of the paper



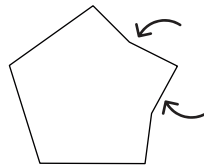
Fold up the end of the paper



Fold the paper accordingly to the edge until the end



Insert the end of the paper through the slit



Pinch the edge of the stars
